

Bowlers Hit The Beach Contest – DEFINITIONS

Grand Prize– \$2,500.00 towards a trip an eligible destination for a maximum of two individuals.

Grand prize Winner – The 1st name drawn for the **Bowlers Hit The Beach** contest.

Secondary Prizes & Winners – The 2nd name drawn (\$500.00 Pro Shop gift certificate) & 3rd name drawn (\$300.00 Pro Shop gift certificate).

Associations – Manitoba Tenpin Federation, Brandon Tenpin Bowling Association, Dauphin Tenpin Association, Winnipeg Tenpin Bowling Association, Manitoba Bowling Association, Manitoba Classic Bowlers Association & their board members, employees & agents.

Adult Bowler - A 21 years of age (as of September 1, 2016) Canadian Tenpin Federation registered member with permanent residency in Manitoba.

Eligible Youth Bowler – A Youth Bowler that is 18 years of age (as of September 1, 2016) & competes in a Canadian Tenpin Federation sanctioned league for the full year (21 games Minimum) & A Canadian Tenpin Federation registered member with permanent residency in Manitoba.

Tenpin Bowling Community – Includes any Canadian Tenpin Federation registered member, their family or friends; Association employees, board members, agents; any individual, owner, employee, agent or family members of any business affiliated with the sport of tenpin bowling.

New Bowler – An individual that hasn't been a Manitoba CTF Registered Participant for a minimum of 3 seasons.

Eligible Destination – (See List – Section B).

Recognized Manitoba Tenpin Bowling Pro Shop
– (See List – Section C).

This Free Draw is open to all Adult Bowlers and eligible Youth Bowlers that are 2016-17 Manitoba Canadian Tenpin Federation Registered Participants, including all Association board members.

4 WAYS TO WIN

1 - All Adult Bowlers are automatically entered into the draw for a chance to win one of the 3 listed prizes. One entry per person – per league. Bowlers also can receive an additional entry for each registered CTF sanctioned league they participate 2/3 of the season in. The Adult Bowler must also complete 2/3 of each league season in order to be eligible for each individual league entry. Those individuals failing to complete 2/3 of the league season will not be eligible for those additional draw entry(ies).

2 - BRING-A-BUDDY BONUS: If a current Adult Bowler recruits a **NEW BOWLER** that registers and completes 2/3 of the season, the recruiter will receive an additional entry into the draw. It is the recruiter's sole responsibility to notify the Association Executive Director of the New Bowlers Name and League in order to receive the bonus entry (See Section D for contact information).

3 – TOURNAMENT PARTICIPATION: All Adult Bowlers & Eligible Youth Bowlers that are 2016-17 Manitoba Canadian Tenpin Federation Registered Participants, that participate in any & all CTF Sanctioned Tournaments as defined above and listed below in Section B. **One entry will be awarded for each and every paid entry per tournament event** (ie. Singles, Doubles &/ or Team).

4 - In tournaments that offer all three or more events, a **Bonus entry** will also be awarded if the participant enters all of the different events in the same tournament.

If anyone wishes to **opt-out of the contest** they may do so by submitting their request in writing to the Manitoba Tenpin Federation by no later than **Midnight of May 31st, 2017**.

All Manitoba Tenpin Federation employees are not eligible to enter.

GRAND PRIZE STIPULATIONS AND WINNER OBLIGATIONS

If for any reason, either the Grand Prize Winner or Secondary Prize Winners fail to accept their prize as stated or fail to claim or use the awarded prize by the stated deadline, there will be no additional draws to determine another winner(s) and the prize(s) will be considered forfeited. (I.e. The prizes will not be awarded *down the line*). Any portion of the Grand Prize or any of the prizes' monetary value not claimed is forfeited. If, for any reason, any portion included as part of the Grand Prize does not occur, that portion of the Grand Prize will be forfeited without additional compensation.

The Associations shall have no responsibility for trip cancellations, alterations, weather delays, weather cancellations or other changes to the trip itinerary and by accepting the Grand Prize; the winner acknowledges and accepts such risks. The Associations do not assume responsibility should any portion of the Grand Prize trip be cancelled, delayed, suspended or rescheduled for any reason beyond its control.

All Grand Prize bookings are to be done through Algonquin Travel and subject to existing availability. Bookings are also subject to all rules and regulations of the applicable airline, hotel/resort and/or Algonquin Travel. The Grand Prize bookings are subject to availability, changes in itinerary and other restrictions. Trip **cannot be modified by winner after confirmation booking with Algonquin Travel.**

The Grand Prize winner may be required by the airline or hotel/resort to provide an accepted and valid credit card to cover incidental charges (included but not limited to: telephone charges, special purchases, etc.)

Entrant may be required to provide Manitoba Tenpin Federation with proof that he/she is the actual identified winner.

By entering this draw, you consent to the "Draw Rules". The Grand Prize Winner must submit a minimum of ten photographs of themselves taken at their eligible destination. Should you become a Grand Prize Winner or a winner of either secondary prizes, your name, city/town of residence and photograph or other likeness, without further compensation or notice may be used, for publicity, advertising or informational purposes in any media or format (including internet) in connection with these Draws. The Associations respect your right to privacy of your personal information.

The Grand Prize Travel Certificate may be used towards airfare, accommodation and related services, taxes and fees at time of booking for the Grand Prize Winner and their guest.

All requests for redemption of the Travel Certificate must be made by the Grand Prize Winner and organized directly with the Manitoba Tenpin Federation. Any expenses of the Grand Prize Winner in excess of the Travel Certificate stated face value are the sole responsibility of the Grand Prize Winner.

All Grand Prize & Secondary Prize Winners must accept their prize as awarded, in accordance with the stated rules.

Grand Prize Winner must sign a form of acceptance of the stated rules prior to the official awarding of the prize. The Grand Prize Winner must complete their trip booking with Algonquin Travel **by no later than January 31, 2018.**

The Grand Prize trip must occur between December 1, 2017 and August 31, 2018.

All Grand Prize Certificates are not transferable, non-refundable, has no cash value and must be accepted as awarded. One of the potential travelers must be the Grand Prize Winner.

The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Draw Rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Draw Rules shall otherwise remain in effect and shall be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provisions were not contained herein.
